Nassau, Bahamas

There are 700 Islands of Bahamas sprinkled over 100,000 square miles of ocean starting just 50 miles off the coast of Florida. The archipelago is an ecological oasis featuring 2,000 breathtaking islands and cays and boasts some of the clearest water on the planet — with a visibility of over 200 feet.

Originally called "the Lucayans" (after the original natives), the name was later changed to The Bahamas by Ponce de Leon's Spanish expedition in 1513. The name is from the Spanish "baja mar", meaning shallow water.

Nassau is the both the capital and the commercial center of the Bahamas. The city is located on the island of New Providence, which has an attractive harbor, a colorful blend of old world and colonial architecture and is also a busy port. The tropical climate and natural beauty of The Bahamas has made Nassau a popular tourist destination.

Brief History

Nassau was formerly known as Charles Town; it was burnt to the ground by the Spanish in 1684, but later rebuilt and renamed Nassau in 1695 in honor of King William III of England. By 1713, the sparsely settled Bahamas had become a pirate rendezvous.

In 1718, the English crown sought to regain control and appointed the task to Captain Woodes Rogers. He ousted Blackbeard, reformed the civil government and successfully expelled the pirates. Rogers cleaned up Nassau and the area enjoyed a

century of peace, until the Americans used the area for military operations during the Revolutionary War.

The British later regained control and maintained it until July 10, 1973. On that date, the Bahamas became a free and sovereign country, ending 325 years of peaceful British rule. Today, the Bahamas is a member of the Commonwealth of Nations and celebrates July 10th as "Bahamian Independence Day".

Highlights

Nassau's narrow cobblestone streets are full of pastel-colored homes that look out onto the Atlantic. The waterfront looks much the same as it did at the dawn of the 20th century. Offering a distinct blend of international glamour and tropical ease, Nassau's highlights include:

Beaches: some of the best beaches in the world can be found on Paradise Island and Cable Beach. All beaches offer all kinds of activities such as snorkeling, sailing and even swimming with dolphins.

Paradise Island: full of grand hotels, perfect beaches, continental restaurants, and glitzy casinos. Not to be missed is the world famous Atlantis resort, which accounts for more tourism than any other hotel property and employs over 6,000 Bahamians

Fort Charlotte: built in the Napoleonic era to defend the island against marauding pirates, this fort offers you a historic peek into the past.

Bay Street: the heart of Nassau's shopping district.
