Personal Choice Dining[®]

Dine according to your schedule. Princess is the only cruise line to offer two dining options:

TRADITIONAL FIXED SEATING

Dine in the Botticelli Dining Room each night, according to your pre-assigned seating arrangement as follows:

First Seating 6:00pm Second Seating 8:15pm**

ANYTIME DININGSM

Anytime dining allows you to dine when and with whom you like in either the Da Vinci Dining Room or Michelangelo Dining Room between 5:30pm and 10:00pm. Emerald Princess also offers three special restaurant experiences in Sabatini's (cover charge applicable), dedicated to Italian alta cucina, the Crown Grill (cover charge applicable), featuring prime cuts of meats and seafood cooked to order, and Café Caribe Dinner Buffet, featuring daily themed specialties. To make a reservation call from your stateroom using the 'Dining Reservation' button on your telephone.

Discretionary Hotel & Dining Charge

During your cruise, you will meet many members of our staff in a variety of locations as they provide you with impeccable service. Additionally, many more crew behind the scenes support those who serve you directly. To save you the worry of who to tip and how much, Princess makes it easier for you to reward excellent service by automatically adding a discretionary Hotel charge of \$11 USD for suites and mini-suites and \$10.50 USD for all other staterooms per passenger per day (including children) to your shipboard account. The Hotel charge will be shared amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the wait-staff, stateroom stewards and housekeeping staff, buffet stewards, food production staff, galley staff and others. Casino dealers and Lotus Spa[®] personnel do not share in the Hotel and Dining charge as not all passengers utilize their services.

Important Safety Notice

Princess Cruises' number one priority is the safety and well-being of our passengers and crew. Therefore, we ask that you read and review the procedures in your Stateroom Portfolio. If you have any questions about these procedures, please ask your Stateroom Steward or any of the Ship's Officers. Prior to sailing, all passengers must attend a Passenger Muster Drill. This drill is a requirement of International Law.

Protecting the Environment

In the interest of energy conservation and to maintain a cool temperature in your stateroom, your Stateroom Steward has been instructed to draw the sheers and turn off all lights during the day when you are out of your stateroom. This keeps the stateroom at a comfortable temperature whilst saving energy.

Please feel free to readjust the temperature and the sheers on your return. Simply inform your steward if you wish to follow a different procedure.

Similar to many hotels ashore, if you wish to re-use your bathroom towels, simply place them on the rack, rail or hook in your bathroom. Towels left on the floor will be replaced by your Steward.

Stateroom TV Entertainment

Princess Overseas Television includes an amazing variety of movies, television programs, live news and sports via satellite as well as music-only channels. Please refer to your TV Guide in the back of your Stateroom Portfolio.

Bathrobes

An embroidered Princess bathrobe is available upon request from your stateroom steward. The robe will be provided for your comfort and convenience while onboard. Should you choose to keep this robe, a charge of \$45 will be applied to your account. If you wish to purchase additional new bathrobes, please visit the ship's Boutique where they are available for \$45. Extra-luxurious terry cloth bathrobes are also available for \$90.

Pool Towels

For your convenience we have provided pool towels. These are for your use on board at the pool, in the Spa, Sauna or Gymnasium Area. If you are heading ashore to the beach, or doing that special snorkeling tour in one of our exciting ports of call, please feel free to take a pool towel with you. We would kindly request however, that you do ensure that all pool towels are returned back onboard.

Please always return these towels to your stateroom as they are your Steward's responsibility. We will provide fresh ones every evening. We will also be happy to supply additional towels upon request.

May we respectfully remind you that there is no need to reserve deck loungers. Any towels left on deck loungers unattended for over 30 minutes may be removed.
