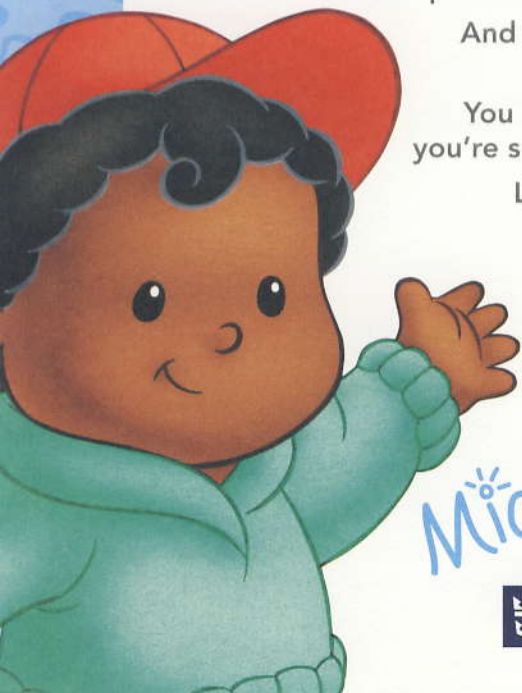

How to Prepare for Class

- **Bring special items**—such as your child's favorite blanket, a drink and a small snack—to each session.
- **An extra shirt** or sweater will keep your child comfortable in air-conditioning.
- You and your child should **dress in loose, comfortable clothing**—physical play is a big part of our day.

Playtips to Go

The activities we'll be sharing with you in our playgroup involve specific toys, but there are many ways you can encourage imaginative discoveries during everyday routines, from playing at home to running errands.

- **Once upon a time ...**
Read stories set in another time or place to spark ideas and awareness. Then take turns acting out scenes from the book, or making up stories of your own. Take it a step further with costumes or props from that period.
- **Wagon train**
In the world of pretend, a tricycle can take a doctor on rounds or a firefighter to a rescue. A wagon becomes a circus train, transporting lions and tigers and bears (oh my!). And any ride-on toy could become a trusty steed fit for a knight or a princess. Encourage your child to use vehicles and toys that move to go on exotic adventures, fueled by imagination.
- **Treasure hunt**
Try this with a new toy or an old favorite. Take turns hiding the toy and searching for it. As you look for the treasure, talking about what you're doing will enhance language and problem-solving skills. "Is it under the cushion? Is it on the table?"
