#### **Important Safety Information for Parents and Guardians**

If your children are participating in Adventure Ocean, our highly trained Youth Staff will take your child(ren) to meet you at your pre-assigned Assembly station.

#### **Parents/Guardians: If you hear the Emergency Signal,**

1. Go to your pre-assigned Assembly station.  
Do not go to the Adventure Ocean facilities, as your child(ren) will not be there.
2. Stand in the front row and await the arrival of your child(ren), if they are not already there.
3. Follow the instructions of the Assembly station leader.

#### **Important**

- Do not go to the youth activities centers!  
Your children are being escorted to their assigned Assembly station and will meet you there.
- Children will be given lifejackets prior to leaving the youth activities centers. In addition, extra lifejackets in child sizes will be available at each Assembly station.
- All children will be supervised at the Assembly stations until they are reunited with their parents/guardians.
