Stateroom Safety Notice

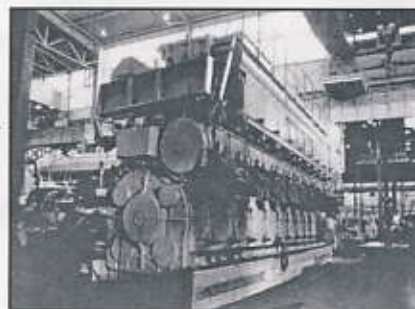

Cunard Soft Drink Package

We are delighted to introduce the Cunard Soft Drinks Package, where a one-time payment allows you to enjoy unlimited soft drinks for the entire voyage. The package entitles the bearer of the card only, to unlimited soft drinks and juices served in a glass in any of the Restaurants and Cocktail Bars. The price per day is \$3.95 per person with a 15% service charge. On purchasing this package, you will receive a coloured sticker attached to your Identity Card. This card must then be presented to the beverage staff when ordering soft drinks. This package does not extend to bottled water, in-cabin beverage service or to any other non-alcoholic beverages.
