At 4.15pm today, ALL PASSENGERS will be exercised at their General Emergency Stations. This exercise is a requirement of law and you must attend. On commencement of the exercise, broadcasts will be made and alarm bells will be sounded, calling you to your Assembly Stations as indicated on the notice behind your bathroom or cabin door. Please carry your life jacket with you; do not wear it, and for safety's sake do not allow the ties to trail on the deck. The correct method of wearing a life jacket will be demonstrated to you at the end of this muster.

**Stateroom Safety Notice**

As your safety is our prime concern, we would like to remind you of some important precautions you must take while in your stateroom or on your balcony:

- Never use lighted candles, naked flames or any other burning material either in your stateroom or on your balcony.
- If you smoke, please use the ashtrays provided for your stateroom or balcony and ensure your cigarette is fully extinguished. Please do not smoke in bed or throw any cigars or cigarettes over the ship's side.
