## FROM THE NAVIGATOR

### NAVIGATION INFORMATION:

Slipping our lines yesterday afternoon, Queen Victoria broke away from her berth and was manoeuvred away from the city of Stockholm. Negotiating the long pilotage out towards the open waters of the Baltic where our pilot was disembarked in the late evening. This morning finds us southbound in the Baltic sea, heading for our next port of call, Copenhagen.

### NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

#### PLIMSOLL MARK

During one of our stops in port, many of you may have noticed a mark painted on the ship's side at about midships, near the sea level. That mark is called Plimsoll Mark and it indicates the draught levels to which a ship may be loaded for varying conditions of season and location. The Plimsoll Mark can show up to six loading levels (tropical fresh water, fresh water, tropical sea water, summer sea water, winter sea water, and winter North Atlantic for vessels shorter than 100 meters). This mark is accompanied by another, consisting of a circle bisected by a horizontal line with letters which indicates the registration society (i.e. "LR" is the code for the "Lloyd's Register", whereas "RI" is the code for the "Registro Navale Italiano"). The horizontal line on the registration mark indicates the summer freeboard.

## Cunard Insights: Scientist Chris Davis

At 11.00am in the Royal Court Theatre, Decks 1, 2 & 3

*"Once around the Sun - a year in the life of the NASA STEREO mission"*

Launched in October 2006, NASA's twin STEREO probes have now been making detailed observations of the Sun and the solar wind for over a year.

As the twin spacecraft speed away from the Earth in opposite directions, they look back at our Sun and make three dimensional observations of the solar surface and solar wind. The Sun's surface is very complex, occasionally erupting and spewing a billion tones of material into space travelling at a million miles an hour. If an eruption sends such a cloud towards the Earth, it can damage satellites and disrupt communications on Earth. STEREO was designed to help us understand why these eruptions occur and to provide advanced warning as to when they might strike Earth. The radiation could prove fatal to astronauts caught up in such a storm and 'space weather' forecasts will be vital if mankind is to successfully colonise the Moon and Mars.
